Last month SEAO included a link to the change.org website where members could sign the petition for the state legislature to continue to fund this valuable resource. On March

20, 2021, Yumei Wang posted that DOGAMI has been saved and a hearty thanks to all of the engineering community for the support.

Over the last two months, many elected officials heard about the value to all Oregonians and on March 20 voted to preserve DOGAMI as an independent scientific agency. Oregonians will continue to have access to unbiased scientific information.
